

Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)


This guide explains how to connect to the eduroam Wi-Fi service for LAMDA staff and students using the CAT tool. Please note:

- You will need your LAMDA user ID (email) and password
- Make sure you are in a location where the eduroam wireless network is available




- You will see the Welcome to eduroam installer window. To run the installer, click **Next**




And then click **OK** to continue the installation




7. When prompted enter your LAMDA email and password and click **Install**
