

LAMDA Terms and Conditions – Applications & Auditions

- The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances other than credit/debit card payment errors.
- A maximum of two audition/interview time slots will be offered per application within the admissions period. A second date offer is entirely dependent on the availability of the audition panel and is not guaranteed. It is the responsibility of the applicant to keep us updated with their availability by emailing auditions@lamda.ac.uk. We will endeavour to offer an audition/interview within your stated availability, however this cannot be guaranteed.
- If applicants do not attend their previously accepted audition slot they must contact auditions@lamda.ac.uk within 48 hours of their scheduled audition, if not their application will be automatically cancelled.
- If an applicant has been unable to attend their audition date and has contacted LAMDA within the requested 48 hours we will try our best to reschedule you however this cannot be guaranteed and is dependent on audition dates available.
- If an applicant has missed two scheduled auditions their application will be automatically cancelled.
- LAMDA aims to provide an environment which in its opinion allows applicants to demonstrate their suitability for training. The audition procedures are intended to be fair and transparent. Entry is on the understanding that there is an acceptance of the professional judgement of the panel. The only grounds for an appeal are if the applicant can claim that the above procedures have not been met; no other grounds will be considered. All appeals must be made in writing within 14 days of the audition date, not the result.
- Feedback is not available following first and second auditions. The audition panel's decision is final. Brief feedback for unsuccessful applicants can be requested following a recall audition. Feedback requests must be received within 14 days of receiving a recall result. More information will be included with the notification of a recall date.
- Applicants are advised to notify LAMDA if they have a disability, prior to audition. This will allow the admissions department to provide suitable facilities and/or support for the audition. If you decide not to disclose a disability, this will limit LAMDA's ability to meet your needs throughout the auditions process. However, applicants should be reassured that any information disclosed that may impact on subsequent training is irrelevant to the decision of the panel.
- Any submission of fraudulent information on this application will result in the immediate cancellation of the application.
- If the applicant is under the age of 18 on the date of application, a parent or guardian must check and agree all details provided and these terms and conditions, before the application is submitted.
- Please check the age restrictions for LAMDA courses before sending payment, as application fees cannot be refunded for invalid applications.
- We reserve the right to refuse applications at our discretion.
