Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is the last date I can register new Learners?

The last date to enter Learners for this qualification is **31 July 2018.** Please make sure that if you intend to register any Learners on this qualification, you do so before this date. After this date the qualification will no longer be available to new Learners and we'll be unable to accept registrations.

What is meant by 'Last Date for Certification'?

The last certification date is the final date LAMDA will produce certificates for this qualification. Centres are therefore urged to plan for completion of all Learner assessment, and submit all relevant documentation, to LAMDA at least two months prior to the last certification date. The final certification date for this qualification is **28 February 2020**. Any results received after this date will not be accepted and Learners will not receive certificates.

What if a Learner has failed a unit?

If they wish to complete the qualification they must retake that unit and submit all relevant documentation before the certification end date of **28 February 2020**.
